11 news of the death of Mr. Roberson Euil, of Rainbow City,
12 Alabama, on February 26, 2012, at the age of 92 years; and

13 WHEREAS, the passing of Mr. Mitchell leaves a void

15 entire community, where he was highly regarded; and

16 WHEREAS, born in Cullman County on March 7, 1919, he
17 was the son of Alfred N. Roberson and Hattie Oden Roberson; a

21 Eisenhower's headquarters in Reims, France, he built bridges,

23 Tire and Rubber Co., Gadsden, Dept. 196, which he served for
24 33 years as a Return Goods Inspector; and

25 WHEREAS, a charter member and deacon of Coosa Valley
26 Baptist Church, he loved his church family; he was an

2 grandchildren; he touched the lives of those who knew him; and

3 WHEREAS, survivors include two daughters, Rhonda
4 Adams and Susan (Eddie) Silvey; two grandsons, Chad Adams and
5 Jason (Lindsey) Silvey; two granddaughters, Amber Brown and
6 Stacy Gray; five great-grandchildren, Cody Brown, Savana
7 Bryant, Mayson Gray, Maddox Gray, and Hayes Silvey; and
8 several nieces and nephews; he was preceded in death by his
9 beloved and devoted wife of 64 years, Evelyn Wallace Roberson;
10 infant son, Terry Roberson; father, Alfred N. Roberson;
11 mother, Hattie Oden Roberson; two brothers, Irie Rutledge and
12 Harold Roberson; sisters, Eveline Evans, Margaret Fisher, and
13 Betty Smith; twin sister, Jewel Roberson; and son-in-law,
14 Sammy D. Adams; and

16 community; although his presence will be greatly missed, his
