11 news of the death of Mr. Clifford L. Callis, Jr., on March 25,
12 2012, at the age of 52 years; and

13 WHEREAS, born in Montgomery, Alabama, on April 25,
14 1960, he was the son of Clifford and Lillian Callis; he was a
15 1983 graduate of Auburn University, where he was a member of
16 the Delta Sigma Phi fraternity; he earned his Juris Doctorate
17 from the Jones School of Law in 1987; and

18 WHEREAS, he served as Assistant District Attorney in
19 Etowah County from 1989 to 1992; he was a partner in the firm,
20 Simmons, Brunson, Sasser, and Callis, where he practiced law
21 from 1993-1995; in 1995, he founded the Callis Law Firm, which
22 he maintained until his passing; he also served as a Municipal
23 Judge for the Cities of Southside and Hokes Bluff, Alabama; he
24 received numerous honors over the years, including an
25 Appointment to the Attorney General and belonged to a number
26 of professional organizations; and

1 WHEREAS, quick-witted, he always had a humorous
2 story, joke, or impression to relate; and

3 WHEREAS, survivors include his best friend and life
4 partner in raising their precious daughters, Carol Dial
5 Callis; daughters and his greatest accomplishment in life, Cam
6 and Courtney; and his mother, Lillian Callis; he was preceded
7 in death by his father, Clifford L. Callis, Sr.; his aunt,
8 Louise Musgrove; and three precious sons, Charlie Dial, Chris
9 and Taylor Callis; now therefore,
