Pursuant to the Alabama Sunset Law, the 6 Sunset Committee recommends the continuance of the Alabama Board of Cosmetology until October 1, 2013. 7 Section 2. The existence and functioning of the 8 9 Alabama Board of Cosmetology, created and functioning pursuant 10 to Sections 34-7A-1 to 34-7A-25, inclusive, Code of Alabama 11 1975, is continued until October 1, 2013, and those code 12 sections are expressly preserved. 13 Section 3. The Legislature concurs in the 14 recommendations of the Sunset Committee as provided in Sections 1 and 2. 15 Section 4. This act shall become effective 16 17 immediately upon its passage and approval by the Governor, or

its otherwise becoming law.
