19	(a) It shall be unlawful for any person fraudulently
20	to misrepresent himself or herself, or any other person or
21	organization with which he or she is affiliated, as speaking
22	or writing or otherwise acting for or on behalf of any
23	candidate, principal campaign committee, political action
24	committee, or political party, or agent or employee thereof,
25	in a manner which is damaging or is intended to be damaging to

such other candidate, principal campaign committee, political action committee, or political party.

(b) It shall be unlawful for any owner, employee, agent, or other representative of any phone bank or other automated telephone dialing service to fraudulently misrepresent himself or herself or any other person or organization with which he or she is affiliated as speaking for or on behalf of any candidate, principal campaign committee, political action committee, or political party or agent or employee in a manner which is damaging or is intended to be damaging to such other candidate, principal campaign committee, political action committee, or political party.

(c) It shall be unlawful for any communication via automated phone bank or other automated telephone dialing service to be conducted without notice at the ending of the phone call that the communication was a paid political advertisement, clearly identifying the identification of the person, nonprofit corporation, entity, principal campaign committee, or political action committee that paid for such communication. The Attorney General of the State of Alabama shall have full power to investigate and enforce violations of this section and any owner, employer, agent or representative of any phone bank and/or automated dialing service found to be in violation of this section shall be guilty upon conviction of a Class A misdemeanor as provided in Code of Alabama 1975, Section 17-17-35(a).

Section 2. This act shall become effective on the first day of the third month following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
