4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. Pursuant to the Alabama Sunset Law, the
Sunset Committee recommends the continuance of the State
Pilotage Commission until October 1, 2016.

8 Section 2. The existence and functioning of the 9 State Pilotage Commission, created and functioning pursuant to 10 Sections 33-4-1 to 33-4-57, inclusive, Code of Alabama 1975, 11 is continued until October 1, 2016, and those code sections 12 are expressly preserved.

Section 3. The Legislature concurs in the
recommendations of the Sunset Committee as provided in
Sections 1 and 2.

16 Section 4. This act shall become effective 17 immediately upon its passage and approval by the Governor, or 18 its otherwise becoming law.
