Section 1. Pursuant to the Alabama Sunset Law, the
Sunset Committee recommends the continuance of the Alabama
Board of Examiners in Psychology until October 1, 2016.

8 Section 2. The existence and functioning of the 9 Alabama Liquefied Petroleum Gas Board, created and functioning 10 pursuant to Sections 34-26-1 to 34-26-66, inclusive, Code of 11 Alabama 1975, is continued until October 1, 2016, and those 12 code sections are expressly preserved.

Section 3. The Legislature concurs in the
recommendations of the Sunset Committee as provided in
Sections 1 and 2.
