1	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
2	Section 1. Pursuant to the Alabama Sunset Law, the
3	Sunset Committee recommends the continuance of the Alcoholic
4	Beverage Control Board until October 1, 2016.
5	Section 2. The existence and functioning of the
6	Alcoholic Beverage Control Board, created and functioning
7	pursuant to Chapter 3 of Title 28, Code of Alabama 1975, is
8	continued until October 1, 2016, and those code sections are
9	expressly preserved.
10	Section 3. The Legislature concurs in the
11	recommendations of the Sunset Committee as provided in
12	Sections 1 and 2.
13	Section 4. This act shall become effective
14	immediately upon its passage and approval by the Governor, or
15	its otherwise becoming law.
