8 SYNOPSIS: Under existing law, termination dates are  
9 established for enumerated state agencies. The  
10 agencies are periodically reviewed by the Alabama  
11 Sunset Committee. After the review process is  
12 completed, the committee prepares its  
13 recommendations for the agencies to the Legislature  
14 in the form of sunset bills which either continue,  
15 terminate, or continue with modification each  
16 agency reviewed.

17 This bill would provide for the continuance  
18 of the Board of Examiners of Assisted Living  
19 Administrators until October 1, 2016.

22 TO BE ENTITLED

25 Relating to the Alabama Sunset Law; to continue the  
26 existence and functioning of the Board of Examiners of  
27 Assisted Living Administrators until October 1, 2016.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

2 Section 1. Pursuant to the Alabama Sunset Law, the  
3 Sunset Committee recommends the continuance of the Board of  
4 Examiners of Assisted Living Administrators until October 1,  
5 2016.

6 Section 2. The existence and functioning of the  
7 Board of Examiners of Assisted Living Administrators, created  
8 and functioning pursuant to Sections 34-2A-1 to 34-2A-16,  
9 inclusive, Code of Alabama 1975, is continued until October 1,  
10 2016, and those code sections are expressly preserved.

11 Section 3. The Legislature concurs in the  
12 recommendations of the Sunset Committee as provided in  
13 Sections 1 and 2.

14 Section 4. This act shall become effective  
15 immediately upon its passage and approval by the Governor, or  
16 its otherwise becoming law.
