4 ENROLLED, An Act,

5 To amend Section 41-9-870, Code of Alabama 1975,  
6 relating to the Alabama Peace Officers Hall of Fame; to  
7 provide further for membership requirements, terms of office,  
8 diversity of membership, and selection of a chair each two  
9 years.

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

11 Section 1. Section 41-9-870 of the Code of Alabama  
12 1975, is amended to read as follows:

13 "§41-9-870.

14 "(a) The Alabama Peace Officers' Hall of Fame Board  
15 is hereby created and established. The board shall be composed  
16 of seven law enforcement officers. Any board member serving on  
17 the effective date of the act adding this language shall serve  
18 a term of four years commencing from that date, and  
19 thereafter, all board members shall be appointed as herein  
20 provided and shall serve a term of office of four years. Each  
21 two years the board shall elect one of its members to serve as  
22 chair. The board members shall be appointed as follows, viz:  
23 One member shall be appointed from the Alabama Peace Officers'  
24 Association; one member shall be appointed from the Alabama  
25 Sheriffs' Association; one member shall be appointed from the

1 Fraternal Order of Police; one member shall be appointed from  
2 the Alabama League of Municipalities; one member shall be  
3 appointed from the Alabama Association of County  
4 Commissioners; one member shall be appointed by the Alabama  
5 Association of Chiefs of Police, and one member shall be  
6 appointed from the Alabama State Troopers Association. Members  
7 of the board shall not be compensated for their services. The  
8 board shall meet annually at the office of the Alabama Peace  
9 Officers' Association, or at such other times and places as  
10 its rules and bylaws may prescribe. A majority of the members  
11 shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business.

12 "(b) The membership of the board shall be inclusive  
13 and reflect the racial, gender, geographic, urban/rural, and  
14 economic diversity of the state."

15 Section 2. This act shall become effective  
16 immediately following its passage and approval by the  
17 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
