Relating to the State Military Department and members of the Alabama National Guard; to amend Section 36-29A-1 of the Code of Alabama 1975, relating to the State Employees Injury Compensation Program, to provide that members of the Alabama National Guard and Alabama State Defense Force who suffer personal injury as a direct result of active military service not covered by the State Employees Injury Compensation Program; to authorize the Military Department to pay medical expenses for members of the National Guard or Alabama State Defense Force who become ill during active military service or have minor injuries as a direct result of active military service for the state not covered by the State Employees Injury Compensation Program; and to repeal Section 31-2-85 of the Code of Alabama 1975, providing compensation for injury, disability, or death of a member of the Alabama National Guard or Alabama State Defense Force.

Section 1. Section 36-29A-1 of the Code of Alabama

1975, is amended to read as follows:

"\$36-29A-1.

"The Director of Finance shall have the authority to implement a program to provide compensation for employees of the state and its agencies, departments, boards, or commissions and members of the Alabama National Guard and Alabama State Defense Force while on active military service for the state who suffer personal injury as a result of accidents arising out of and in the course of their state employment or active military service, under such terms and conditions as the Director of Finance shall determine. The said program will be administered by the Division of Risk Management of the Department of Finance, and will take effect on October 1, 1994."

Section 2. The Military Department may pay medical expenses for members of the National Guard or Alabama State

Defense Force who become ill during active military service or who have minor injuries as a direct result of active military service for the state not covered by the State Employees

Injury Compensation Program.

Section 3. Section 31-2-85 of the Code of Alabama 1975, is repealed. Section 4. This act shall become effective on the first day of the third month following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
