4 ENROLLED, An Act,

5 Relating to the State Military Department and
6 members of the Alabama National Guard; to amend Section
7 36-29A-1 of the Code of Alabama 1975, relating to the State
8 Employees Injury Compensation Program, to provide that members
9 of the Alabama National Guard and Alabama State Defense Force
10 who suffer personal injury as a direct result of active
11 military service not covered by the State Employees Injury
12 Compensation Program; to authorize the Military Department to
13 pay medical expenses for members of the National Guard or
14 Alabama State Defense Force who become ill during active
15 military service or have minor injuries as a direct result of
16 active military service for the state not covered by the State
17 Employees Injury Compensation Program; and to repeal Section
18 31-2-85 of the Code of Alabama 1975, providing compensation
19 for injury, disability, or death of a member of the Alabama
20 National Guard or Alabama State Defense Force.

21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

22 Section 1. Section 36-29A-1 of the Code of Alabama
23 1975, is amended to read as follows:

24 "§36-29A-1.

1 "The Director of Finance shall have the authority to
2 implement a program to provide compensation for employees of
3 the state and its agencies, departments, boards, or
4 commissions and members of the Alabama National Guard and
5 Alabama State Defense Force while on active military service
6 for the state who suffer personal injury as a result of
7 accidents arising out of and in the course of their state
8 employment or active military service, under such terms and
9 conditions as the Director of Finance shall determine. The
10 said program will be administered by the Division of Risk
11 Management of the Department of Finance, and will take effect
12 on October 1, 1994."

13 Section 2. The Military Department may pay medical
14 expenses for members of the National Guard or Alabama State
15 Defense Force who become ill during active military service or
16 who have minor injuries as a direct result of active military
17 service for the state not covered by the State Employees
18 Injury Compensation Program.

19 Section 3. Section 31-2-85 of the Code of Alabama
20 1975, is repealed.

21 Section 4. This act shall become effective on the
22 first day of the third month following its passage and
23 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
