"In the event of all or part of the National Guard of Alabama being called, drafted, or ordered into the service of the United States, the Governor is hereby authorized to may organize, equip, train, and maintain, only during periods when the National Guard of Alabama is in the federal service or when the Governor declares by executive order, at such the strength and in such the organizations and branches of the service as he or she may deem advisable, a temporary military augmentation force designated as the Alabama State Defense Force, similar to the National Guard and organized for the same state purposes, and if authorized by federal laws, it shall be organized, maintained, and trained under the provisions of the National Defense Act for the organization, maintenance and training of the National Guard; provided that comparable organizations shall be disbanded and discharged from the service of the state on the release or discharge of the National Guard of Alabama, or units thereof, from the federal service and return to its National Guard status for the purpose of augmenting and assisting the Alabama National Guard under the command of the Adjutant General. The Adjutant General may adopt rules governing the activities and employment of the Alabama State Defense Force and the rules
