26	Institute. The funds in the special fund are continuously		

appropriated for the exclusive use of the Law Institute, shall be maintained separately, and shall be in addition to any other funds appropriated to the Law Institute.

Section 2. The Alabama Law Institute shall provide a public report of all funds received pursuant to this act. The public report shall be made on the website of the Alabama Law Institute.

Section 3. This act shall become effective immediately following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
