11 Relating to the Alabama Law Institute; to authorize
12 the Alabama Law Institute to receive direct grants or
13 contributions from municipal, county, state, federal, or
14 charitable sources, or any other sources, to conduct studies,
15 educate public officials, and carry on the duties of the Law
16 Institute.

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

18 Section 1. Section 29-8-6 is added to the Code of
19 Alabama 1975, to read as follows:

20 §29-8-6.

21 The Alabama Law Institute may establish a special
22 fund in the State Treasury to receive direct grants or
23 contributions from municipal, county, state, federal, or
24 charitable sources, or any other sources, to conduct studies,
25 educate public officials, and carry on the duties of the Law
26 Institute. The funds in the special fund are continuously

1 appropriated for the exclusive use of the Law Institute, shall
2 be maintained separately, and shall be in addition to any
3 other funds appropriated to the Law Institute.

4 Section 2. The Alabama Law Institute shall provide a
5 public report of all funds received pursuant to this act. The
6 public report shall be made on the website of the Alabama Law
7 Institute.

8 Section 3. This act shall become effective
9 immediately following its passage and approval by the
10 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
