8 COMMENDING LIEUTENANT COLONEL RANDY E. MCGEE FOR  
9 PROFESSIONAL ACHIEVEMENT AND DEDICATED SERVICE.

11 WHEREAS, highest commendation is herein conveyed to  
12 Lieutenant Colonel Randy E. McGee, Adjutant General, United  
13 States Army, in recognition of his outstanding achievements  
14 and dedicated service during a distinguished military career  
15 spanning 40 years; and

16 WHEREAS, Lieutenant Colonel McGee is retiring from  
17 his position as the Director of Operations and Services for  
18 AMCON's Contracting Center-Redstone Arsenal; he joined the  
19 Army in 1982 and has been promoted steadily through the ranks,  
20 serving with exceptional competence and commitment in many  
21 stations across the nation and in Europe, and was deployed for  
22 eight months to Kandahar, Afghanistan, as Chief of Contracting  
23 in support of Operation Enduring Freedom; and

24 WHEREAS, from 2007-2009, he was Course Director and  
25 Professor of Contracting at the United States Army Logistics  
26 Management College-Huntsville Campus; during this time, he  
27 traveled to Kuwait and to several locations stateside,

1 providing valuable training to soldiers deployed or preparing  
2 to deploy; and

3 WHEREAS, in August 2009, he was assigned as Director  
4 of Operations and Services at Redstone Arsenal, supervising  
5 almost 100 civil servants working in four separate divisions  
6 ranging from installation support to professional services to  
7 secure government contracting; the overall obligation of funds  
8 through contract actions for these organizations approximates  
9 \$900 million annually; and

10 WHEREAS, Lieutenant Colonel McGee's military  
11 education includes: Adjutant General Officer Basic Course,  
12 Airborne Course, Adjutant General Advanced Course, Combined  
13 Arms and Services Staff School, and Command and General Staff  
14 College; he also holds a Bachelor's Degree in Business  
15 Administration from The University of Dubuque in Dubuque,  
16 Iowa, and Master of Science Degree from Florida Institute of  
17 Technology; and

18 WHEREAS, his awards and decorations include: Defense  
19 Meritorious Service Medal, Meritorious Service Medal (with two  
20 Oak Leaf Clusters), Joint Service Commendation Medal (with one  
21 Oak Leaf Cluster), Army Commendation Medal (with six Oak Leaf  
22 Clusters), Joint Service Achievement Medal, Army Achievement  
23 Medal (with six Oak Leaf Clusters), Army Good Conduct Medal  
24 (with two Bronze Loops), Armed Forces Service Medal, National  
25 Defense Service Medal (with one Bronze Service Star), the NATO  
26 Medal, Joint Meritorious Unit Award, Parachutist's Badge, and  
27 Driver/Mechanic Badge; and

3                   unwavering commitment to freedom and democracy, and he is
