13 Relating to Mobile County; to authorize the Mobile
14 County Commission to impose an additional issuance fee in the
15 office of the license commissioner; and to provide for the use
16 of the proceeds from the issuance fee for the upgrading and
17 maintaining of records, equipment, and technology within the
18 office of the license commissioner

19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

20 Section 1. (a) In Mobile County, the Mobile County
21 Commission may impose, by resolution of the commission, a
22 special issuance fee not to exceed five dollars (\$5) to be
23 collected by the License Commissioner of Mobile County on each
24 motor vehicle registration, boat renewal or registration,
25 manufactured home registration, business license application,
26 or other instrument registered or application applied for in
27 the office of the license commissioner. The special issuance

1 fee shall be in addition to all other fees, taxes, and other
2 charges provided by law.

3 (b) The fee authorized by this act shall be set by
4 the Mobile County Commission, by resolution of the commission,
5 adopted at a regularly scheduled meeting.

6 Section 2. The issuance fees collected pursuant to
7 this act shall be deposited in a segregated account of the
8 office of the license commissioner and expended by the license
9 commissioner for the preservation and storage of records
10 relating to motor vehicle registration, boat registration, and
11 business licenses as prescribed by the Department of Examiners
12 of Public Accounts and for the purchase, installation,
13 improvement, development, upgrading, and maintenance of
14 equipment and technology in the office of the License
15 Commissioner of Mobile County.

16 Section 3. This act is cumulative and shall not
17 alter or change any existing law relating to charges and fees
18 collected by the License Commissioner of Mobile County.

19 Section 4. All laws or parts of laws which conflict
20 with this act are repealed.

21 Section 5. This act shall become effective
22 immediately following its passage and approval by the
23 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
