SYNOPSIS: This bill would propose an amendment to the 8 Constitution of Alabama of 1901, that would provide 9 10 that no person may be elected to the Legislature 11 for more than three full consecutive terms. The 12 amendment would provide that an election to the 13 Senate or the House of Representatives for at least 14 two years would be equivalent to the election for a 15 full term in that body. The amendment would provide that service in the Senate and in the House of 16 17 Representatives prior to November, 2014, would not 18 disqualify, in whole or in part, the person from 19 service in those bodies following that date. The 20 amendment would provide that a person, after the 21 expiration of a legislative quadrennium from his or 22 her third consecutive term, may serve as a member 23 of the Legislature if the person has not served in 24 any capacity with the State of Alabama or any of 25 its departments, agencies, boards, commission, or 26 public educational institutions on a compensated or non-compensated basis, or has not received 27

1 compensation for seeking the passage, defeat, or 2 modification of legislation by conveying information and opinion to legislators or 3 4 influencing the actions of the State of Alabama or any of its departments, agencies, boards, 5 commissions, or public educational institutions. 6 7 A BILL 8 TO BE ENTITLED 9 10 AN ACT 11 12 To propose an amendment to the Constitution of 13 Alabama of 1901, that would provide that no person may be 14 elected to the Senate or the House of Representatives, or both, to more than three consecutive full terms in the 15 16 Legislature; to provide that service in the Senate or the 17 House of Representatives prior to November, 2014, would not disqualify, in whole or in part, the person from election to 18 those bodies following such date; and to allow a person to be 19 elected, after the expiration of a legislative quadrennium 20 21 from his or her third consecutive term, on certain conditions. 22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA: 23 Section 1. The following amendment to the

24 Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended, is proposed and 25 shall become valid as a part thereof when approved by a 26 majority of the qualified electors voting thereon and in 1 accordance with Sections 284, 285, and 287 of the Constitution 2 of Alabama of 1901, as amended:

PROPOSED AMENDMENT

4 (a) For purposes of this amendment, service in or
5 election to the Legislature means service in or election to
6 the Senate, the House of Representatives, or cumulative
7 service in or election to both.

(b) No person may be elected to the Legislature for 8 more than three full consecutive terms. An election to the 9 10 Senate or the House of Representatives for at least two years shall be equivalent to the election of the person for a full 11 12 term in the body. Service in the Senate or House of 13 Representatives prior to November, 2014, shall not disqualify, 14 in whole or in part, a person from service in such bodies 15 following that date.

16 (c) A person may be elected as a member of the 17 Legislature at the second or later legislative quadrennium 18 after completion of his or her third consecutive term if the 19 person, after completion of the third consecutive term, has 20 not:

(1) Served in any capacity with the State of Alabama
or any of its departments, agencies, boards, commission, or
public educational institutions on a compensated or
non-compensated basis.

(2) Received compensation for seeking the passage,
 defeat, or modification of legislation by conveying
 information or opinions, or both, to legislators or

influencing the actions of the State of Alabama or any of its
 departments, agencies, boards, commissions, or public
 educational institutions.

4 (d) Subsection (c) does not apply to a former state
5 senator or state representative who is awarded a competitively
6 bid state contract.

7 Section 2. An election upon the proposed amendment 8 shall be held in accordance with Sections 284 and 285 of the 9 Constitution of Alabama of 1901, now appearing as Sections 284 10 and 285 of the Official Recompilation of the Constitution of 11 Alabama of 1901, as amended, and the election laws of this 12 state.

13 Section 3. The appropriate election official shall 14 assign a ballot number for the proposed constitutional 15 amendment on the election ballot and shall set forth the 16 following description of the substance or subject matter of 17 the proposed constitutional amendment:

"Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of 18 Alabama of 1901, to prohibit a person from being elected to 19 20 the Senate or to the House of Representatives, or both, for 21 more than three consecutive full terms; to provide that an 22 election to the Senate or to the House of Representatives for 23 at least two years would be equivalent to the election of such 24 person for a full term in such body; to provide that service 25 in the Senate or the House of Representatives prior to 26 November, 2014, would not disqualify, in whole or in part, the 27 person from service in such bodies following that date; and to

1 allow a person to be elected at the second or later 2 legislative quadrennium after his or her third consecutive term, if the person, after the legislative service, is not 3 4 employed or associated with the State of Alabama or any of its departments, agencies, boards, commissions, or public 5 educational institutions or receives compensation for seeking 6 7 the passage, defeat, or modification of legislation by conveying information and opinions to legislators or 8 influencing the actions of the State of Alabama or any of its 9 10 departments, agencies, boards, commissions, or public 11 educational institutions. "Proposed by Act _____ ." 12

13This description shall be followed by the following14language:

15 "Yes () No ()."
