Section 14-3-58, Code of Alabama 1975, is 24 25 amended to read as follows: "§14-3-58. 26

"(a) This section shall be known as the "Joel 1 2 Willmore Act." "(b) Whenever any convict an inmate escapes from a 3 penal facility, of the Department of Corrections as defined in 4 5 subdivision (3) of subsection (b) of Section 13A-10-30, it 6 shall be the duty of the Board of Corrections department to 7 take all proper measures for his or her apprehension, and for that purpose, it must forthwith shall notify the following 8 9 within 12 hours of the escape: 10 "(1) communicate to the Governor the fact of such 11 escape, The Governor. "(2) The Department of Public Safety. 12 13 "(3) The sheriff and district attorney of the county where the escape occurred. 14 15 "(4) The chief of police where the escape occurred, 16 if the escape occurred within a municipality. 17 "(5) The sheriff and district attorney of the county where the last conviction of the escapee occurred. 18 "(6) The chief of police where the last conviction 19 20 of the escapee occurred, if the conviction occurred within a 21 municipality. 22 "(7) The sheriff of the county where the convict's home of record is located. 23 24 "(8) The chief of police where the convict's home of record is located, if the location is within a municipality. 25

"(9) All electronic media outlets broadcasting from 1 2 within a radius of 75 miles from where the escape occurred, including all radio and television stations. 3 "(c) The notification required in subsection (b) 4 5 shall include the time when and the circumstances under which 6 it the escape was effected, together with a particular 7 description of the convict inmate, including a copy of the inmate's most recent mug shot, and in what county convicted 8 9 and for what offense and when; 10 "(d) In addition to the requirements set forth in 11 subsections (b) and (c), the department shall post a notification on its website of the escape. The notification 12 13 shall include the time when and the circumstances under which the escape was effected, together with a particular 14 description of the inmate, including a copy of the inmate's 15 most recent mug shot, and in what county convicted and for 16 17 what offense and when. "(e) The Director of Central Records, or his or her 18 designee, of the department shall enter the inmate into the 19 20 National Crime Information Center within 12 hours of the 21 inmate's escape. 22 "(f) The Department of Corrections and the board shall offer a reward, not exceeding \$400.00 four hundred 23 24 dollars (\$400), for the apprehension of such the state 25 convict, to be paid out of the proceeds of the labor of 26 convicts inmates in the State Treasury. But no warrant shall

be issued for the payment of any such reward unless there is filed in the office of the Department of Finance the certificate of the board <u>Department of Corrections</u> that such <u>convict</u> the inmate has been recaptured and restored to custody."

6 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the 7 first day of the third month following its passage and 8 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
