6 Said property is lying in the SW diagonal 1/2 of 7 Section 11, Township 6 South, Range 9 East of the Huntsville 8 Meridian in DeKalb County, Alabama and containing 320 acres 9 more or less.

Section 2. In accordance with Section 11-42-6(b) of the Code of Alabama 1975, a map showing what territory is proposed to be annexed to the City of Fort Payne is on file in the office of the Judge of Probate in DeKalb County, Alabama, and the map is open to the inspection of the public.
