10 TO BE ENTITLED
11 AN ACT
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13 To alter, rearrange, and extend the boundary lines
14 and corporate limits of the City of Fort Payne in DeKalb
15 County.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

17 Section 1. The boundary lines and corporate limits
18 of the City of Fort Payne in DeKalb County are altered,
19 rearranged, and extended to include within the corporate
20 limits of the city, in addition to the lands now included, all
21 of the following territory:

22 Beginning at the SE corner of Section 11, Township 6
23 South, Range 9 East of the Huntsville Meridian run west with
24 the south line of Section 11 and the present corporate
25 boundary for a distance of 5,280 ft. more or less to the SW
26 corner of the said Section 11; thence north with the west line
27 of Section 11 and the present corporate boundary for a

1 distance of 5,280 ft. more or less to the NW corner of the
2 said Section 11; thence southeasterly with the present
3 corporate boundary for a distance of 7,470 ft. more or less to
4 the SE corner of the said Section 11 and the point of
5 beginning.

6 Said property is lying in the SW diagonal 1/2 of
7 Section 11, Township 6 South, Range 9 East of the Huntsville
8 Meridian in DeKalb County, Alabama and containing 320 acres
9 more or less.

10 Section 2. In accordance with Section 11-42-6(b) of
11 the Code of Alabama 1975, a map showing what territory is
12 proposed to be annexed to the City of Fort Payne is on file in
13 the office of the Judge of Probate in DeKalb County, Alabama,
14 and the map is open to the inspection of the public.

15 Section 3. This act shall become effective on the
16 first day of the third month following its passage and
17 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
