ENROLLED, An Act,

To alter, rearrange, and extend the boundary lines and corporate limits of the City of Tuscaloosa and the City of Northport in Tuscaloosa County to remove certain property from the corporate limits of the City of Tuscaloosa and add the property to the City of Northport.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. The boundary lines and corporate limits of the City of Tuscaloosa and the City of Northport in Tuscaloosa County are altered and rearranged to remove from the corporate limits of the City of Tuscaloosa, all of the following territory and to add the territory to the City of Northport:

As the Point of Beginning, commence at the intersection of the centerline of Hargrove Creek and the north bank of the Black Warrior River; said intersection being located in the Southeast 1/4 of Section 20, Township 21 South, Range 10 West; thence south along a line parallel to the west line of said Southeast 1/4 to its intersection with the centerline of the Black Warrior River; said centerline being defined as a line located equidistant from the northwest and southeast edge of water at normal pool elevation; thence northeastwardly along the meanderings of the centerline of the Black Warrior River to its intersection with a line being

1 located 1,400 feet, more or less, west of and parallel to the
2 east line of Section 15, Township 21 South, Range 10 West;
3 thence north along said line to its intersection with the east
4 line of Two Mile Creek (Snow's Mill Creek); thence
5 southwesterly along the meanderings of the north bank of the
6 Black Warrior River to the Point of Beginning. Said parcel
7 being subject to existing easements and rights-of-ways
8 heretofore granted.

9 Section 2. In accordance with Section 11-42-6(b) of
10 the Code of Alabama 1975, a map showing what territory is
11 proposed to be removed from the City of Tuscaloosa and added
12 to the City of Northport in Tuscaloosa County is on file in
13 the office of the Judge of Probate in Tuscaloosa County,
14 Alabama, and the map is open to the inspection of the public.

15 Section 3. This act shall become effective on the
16 first day of the third month following its passage and
17 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
