9 A BILL
10 TO BE ENTITLED
11 AN ACT

13 To alter, rearrange, and extend the boundary lines
14 and corporate limits of the City of Tuscaloosa and the City of
15 Northport in Tuscaloosa County to remove certain property from
16 the corporate limits of the City of Tuscaloosa and add the
17 property to the City of Northport.

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

19 Section 1. The boundary lines and corporate limits
20 of the City of Tuscaloosa and the City of Northport in
21 Tuscaloosa County are altered and rearranged to remove from
22 the corporate limits of the City of Tuscaloosa, all of the
23 following territory and to add the territory to the City of
24 Northport:

25 As the Point of Beginning, commence at the
26 intersection of the centerline of Hargrove Creek and the north
27 bank of the Black Warrior River; said intersection being

1 located in the Southeast 1/4 of Section 20, Township 21 South,
2 Range 10 West; thence south along a line parallel to the west
3 line of said Southeast 1/4 to its intersection with the
4 centerline of the Black Warrior River; said centerline being
5 defined as a line located equidistant from the northwest and
6 southeast edge of water at normal pool elevation; thence
7 northeastwardly along the meanderings of the centerline of the
8 Black Warrior River to its intersection with a line being
9 located 1,400 feet, more or less, west of and parallel to the
10 east line of Section 15, Township 21 South, Range 10 West;
11 thence north along said line to its intersection with the east
12 line of Two Mile Creek (Snow's Mill Creek); thence
13 southwestwardly along the meanderings of the north bank of the
14 Black Warrior River to the Point of Beginning. Said parcel
15 being subject to existing easements and rights-of-ways
16 heretofore granted.

17 Section 2. In accordance with Section 11-42-6(b) of
18 the Code of Alabama 1975, a map showing what territory is
19 proposed to be removed from the City of Tuscaloosa and added
20 to the City of Northport in Tuscaloosa County is on file in
21 the office of the Judge of Probate in Tuscaloosa County,
22 Alabama, and the map is open to the inspection of the public.

23 Section 3. This act shall become effective on the
24 first day of the third month following its passage and
25 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
