24	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
25	Section 1. (a) For the purposes of this act, a "food
26	pantry" is a charitable, nonprofit organization which
27	collects, purchases, or otherwise accumulates food and food

related items for distribution without any charge for
charitable purposes.

(b) A food pantry is exempt from all state, county, 3 4 and municipal sales and use taxes on the purchase or distribution of food and food related items for charitable 5 6 purposes provided the food pantry has been granted status as a 7 tax exempt organization under Section 501(c)(3) of the federal Internal Revenue Code and provided it pays no person any 8 salary or expenses for the performance of any duties related 9 10 to its charitable operations.

Section 2. All laws or parts of laws which conflict with this act are repealed.

Section 3. This act shall become effective on the first day of the third month following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
