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ENROLLED, An Act,

Relating to DeKalb County; to amend Section 45-25-160.03, Code of Alabama 1975, providing for the distribution of certain TVA in-lieu-of-taxes payments received by the county; to further increase the share going to the DeKalb County Economic Development Authority for the fiscal years beginning October 1, 2013, 2014, and 2015.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. Section 45-25-160.03, Code of Alabama 1975, is amended to read as follows:

"§45-25-160.03.

"The distribution of the share of in-lieu-of-taxes payments of T.V.A. for DeKalb County shall be as follows:

"(1) DeKalb County Economic Development Authority shall be appropriated the first fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) through the fiscal year ending September 30, 2013. Beginning October 1, 2013, the DeKalb County Economic Development Authority shall receive the following appropriations:

"a. Fiscal year 2013-2014, the first seventy-five thousand dollars (\$75,000).

"b. Fiscal year 2014-2015, the first one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000).

1 "c. Fiscal year 2015-2016, the first one hundred
2 twenty-five thousand dollars (\$125,000).

3 "d. In the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2016,
4 and beyond, the amount appropriated to the DeKalb County
5 Economic Development Authority shall remain at one hundred
6 twenty-five thousand dollars (\$125,000), unless otherwise
7 specified by local act of the Legislature.

8 "(2) Of the amount remaining after the distributions
9 described in subdivision (1), 37 percent shall be distributed
10 to the county and city boards of education on a per pupil
11 basis as determined by the student enrollment of the
12 respective school systems at the end of the first 40-day
13 enrollment period.

14 "(3) Of the 63 percent remaining after the
15 distributions described in subdivisions (1) and (2),
16 seventy-five thousand dollars (\$75,000) shall be appropriated
17 to the DeKalb County Economic Development Authority.

18 "(4) After the distributions described in
19 subdivisions (1), (2), and (3) are made, sixteen thousand six
20 hundred sixty-six dollars sixty seven cents (\$16,666.67) shall
21 be distributed in equal monthly installments to the Animal
22 Adoption Center Fund held by the DeKalb County Commission.

23 "(5) After the distributions described in
24 subdivisions (1), (2), (3), and (4) are made, two thousand
25 five hundred dollars (\$2,500) shall be distributed to the

1 county general fund for the purpose of operating an emergency
2 communications program whereby the county may make mass
3 emergency responses to the residents of the county.

4 "(6) After the distributions described in
5 subdivisions (1), (2), (3), (4), and (5) are made, 50 percent
6 of the remaining amount shall be distributed to the county
7 general fund and 50 percent of the remaining amount shall be
8 distributed between the municipalities on the basis of
9 population according to the most recent federal decennial
10 census.

11 "(7) For municipalities that employ an animal
12 control officer, a pro rata share of the amounts transferred
13 to the county's Animal Control Center Fund pursuant to
14 subdivision (4), on the basis of population according to the
15 most recent federal census, shall be added to the
16 municipalities' monthly distribution under subdivision (6), so
17 long as the municipality employs an animal control officer."

18 Section 2. This act shall become effective
19 immediately following its passage and approval by the
20 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
