14	45-25-160.03, Code of Alabama 1975, providing for the
15	distribution of certain TVA in-lieu-of-taxes payments received

18	years beginning October 1, 2013, 2014, and 2015.
19	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
20	Section 1. Section 45-25-160.03, Code of Alabama
21	1975, is amended to read as follows:
22	"\$45-25-160.03.
23	"The distribution of the share of in-lieu-of-taxes
24	payments of T.V.A. for DeKalb County shall be as follows:
25	"(1) DeKalb County Economic Development Authority
26	shall be appropriated the first fifty thousand dollars
27	(\$50,000) through the fiscal year ending September 30, 2013

1	Beginning October 1, 2013, the DeKalb County Economic
2	Development Authority shall receive the following
3	appropriations:
4	"a. Fiscal year 2013-2014, the first seventy-five
5	thousand dollars (\$75,000).
6	"b. Fiscal year 2014-2015, the first one hundred
7	thousand dollars (\$100,000).
8	"c. Fiscal year 2015-2016, the first one hundred
9	twenty-five thousand dollars (\$125,000).
10	"d. In the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2016,
11	and beyond, the amount appropriated to the DeKalb County
12	Economic Development Authority shall remain at one hundred
13	twenty-five thousand dollars (\$125,000), unless otherwise
14	specified by local act of the Legislature.
15	"(2) Of the amount remaining after the distributions
16	described in subdivision (1), 37 percent shall be distributed
17	to the county and city boards of education on a per pupil
18	basis as determined by the student enrollment of the
19	respective school systems at the end of the first 40-day
20	enrollment period.
21	"(3) Of the 63 percent remaining after the
22	distributions described in subdivisions (1) and (2),
23	seventy-five thousand dollars (\$75,000) shall be appropriated
24	to the DeKalb County Economic Development Authority.
25	"(4) After the distributions described in
26	subdivisions (1) , (2) , and (3) are made, sixteen thousand six
27	hundred sixty-six dollars sixty seven cents (\$16,666.67) shall

be distributed in equal monthly installments to the Animal
Adoption Center Fund held by the DeKalb County Commission.

"(5) After the distributions described in subdivisions (1), (2), (3), and (4) are made, two thousand five hundred dollars (\$2,500) shall be distributed to the county general fund for the purpose of operating an emergency communications program whereby the county may make mass emergency responses to the residents of the county.

"(6) After the distributions described in subdivisions (1), (2), (3), (4), and (5) are made, 50 percent of the remaining amount shall be distributed to the county general fund and 50 percent of the remaining amount shall be distributed between the municipalities on the basis of population according to the most recent federal decennial census.

"(7) For municipalities that employ an animal control officer, a pro rata share of the amounts transferred to the county's Animal Control Center Fund pursuant to subdivision (4), on the basis of population according to the most recent federal census, shall be added to the municipalities' monthly distribution under subdivision (6), so long as the municipality employs an animal control officer."

Section 2. This act shall become effective immediately following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
