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ENROLLED, An Act,

Relating to Bibb County; authorizing the sheriff to operate a jail store for prisoners in county custody; providing for the deposit of the proceeds in the county general fund earmarked for an increase in salaries in the sheriff's department.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. The Sheriff of Bibb County or the authorized agents of the sheriff may operate a jail store for prisoners within the confines of the county jail. The jail store shall be operated to serve the needs of the jail population. The sheriff may contract with a provider to supply and operate the jail store.

Section 2. (a) All proceeds collected under this act shall be deposited in the county general fund. All jail store transactions shall be accounted for in the fund. When presented with a request from the sheriff, the county commission shall provide the sheriff with the total amount generated from the jail store.

(b) All revenue generated by the jail store shall be deposited into the county general fund earmarked solely to fund an increase in salaries of the employees in the sheriff's department.

1 Section 3. The sheriff shall keep an account of all
2 jail store sales. The jail store account shall be audited at
3 the same time other accounts of the sheriff are audited. The
4 Department of Examiners of Public Accounts shall submit a copy
5 of the audit to the sheriff and county commission within 30
6 days of its completion.

7 Section 4. This act shall become effective
8 immediately following its passage and approval by the
9 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
