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9 A BILL  
10 TO BE ENTITLED  
11 AN ACT  
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13 Relating to Bibb County; authorizing the sheriff to  
14 operate a jail store for prisoners in county custody;  
15 providing for the deposit of the proceeds in the county  
16 general fund earmarked for an increase in salaries in the  
17 sheriff's department.

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

19 Section 1. The Sheriff of Bibb County or the  
20 authorized agents of the sheriff may operate a jail store for  
21 prisoners within the confines of the county jail. The jail  
22 store shall be operated to serve the needs of the jail  
23 population. The sheriff may contract with a provider to supply  
24 and operate the jail store.

25 Section 2. (a) All proceeds collected under this act  
26 shall be deposited in the county general fund. All jail store  
27 transactions shall be accounted for in the fund. When

1 presented with a request from the sheriff, the county  
2 commission shall provide the sheriff with the total amount  
3 generated from the jail store.

4 (b) All revenue generated by the jail store shall be  
5 deposited into the county general fund earmarked solely to  
6 fund an increase in salaries of the employees in the sheriff's  
7 department.

8 Section 3. The sheriff shall keep an account of all  
9 jail store sales. The jail store account shall be audited at  
10 the same time other accounts of the sheriff are audited. The  
11 Department of Examiners of Public Accounts shall submit a copy  
12 of the audit to the sheriff and county commission within 30  
13 days of its completion.

14 Section 4. This act shall become effective  
15 immediately following its passage and approval by the  
16 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
