BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. The following amendment to the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, is proposed and shall become valid as a part of the Constitution when all requirements of this act are fulfilled:

PROPOSED AMENDMENT

- (a) (1) Commencing on the ratification of this constitutional amendment, beginning October 1, 2014, the proceeds from the existing ad valorem tax on motor vehicles levied pursuant to Section 45-2-242 of the Code of Alabama 1975, shall be distributed for the previous tax year to the Baldwin Community and Economic Development Foundation, Inc. The proceeds from the ad valorem tax shall be distributed for 12 months beginning on the first day of the month after the ratification of this amendment to the foundation as follows:
- a. Sixty percent of the proceeds shall be expended on infrastructure and incentivizing new job creation projects.
- b. The balance of the proceeds shall be expended on marketing and organizational initiatives pertaining to new job creation in Baldwin County.

- 1 (2) The proceeds referenced in this amendment may 2 not be used for the salary of any employees of Baldwin County or for any other personnel expenditures of the county. 3 (b) The Legislature may provide by local law for the implementation and administration of this amendment. 5 Section 2. An election upon the proposed amendment 6 7 shall be held at the next general election in the year 2014 in accordance with Amendment 555 to the Constitution of Alabama 8 of 1901, now appearing as Section 284.01 of the Official 9 10 Recompilation of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended, and the election laws of this state. 11 12 Section 3. The appropriate election official shall 13 assign a ballot number for the proposed constitutional 14 amendment on the election ballot and shall set forth the 15 following description of the substance or subject matter of 16 the proposed constitutional amendment: 17 "Relating to Baldwin County, proposing an amendment to the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, to provide that the 18 proceeds from a currently existing ad valorem tax on motor 19 vehicles levied pursuant to Section 45-2-242, Code of Alabama 20 21 1975, and Act 90-449 distributed to the county volunteer fire 22 departments and volunteer municipal fire departments located 23 in Baldwin County shall be distributed to the Baldwin 24 Community and Economic Development Foundation, Inc. "Proposed by Act ." 25
