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ENROLLED, An Act,

To alter, rearrange, and extend the boundary lines and corporate limits of the City of Springville in St. Clair County.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. The boundary lines and corporate limits of the City of Springville in St. Clair County are altered, rearranged, and extended to include within the corporate limits of the municipality, in addition to the lands now included, all of the following territory:

From the Northeast corner of the NE 1/4 of the NE 1/4 of Sections 12, Township 15 South, Range 1 East, go North 89°16'00" West, 699.09 feet to the Northwest right of way line of I-59; thence, South 27°31'00" West, 265.78 feet for a point of beginning; Thence South 28°14'51" West 580.68 feet along the Northwest right of way line of I-59; thence, North 62°24'59" West, 305.63 feet to the center line of Simmons' Mountain Road. Thence turn an angle to the right of 80°03'44", tangent to a curve to the left which has a delta angle of 17°37'19" and a radius of 866.14 feet; thence, left along the arc of said curve, 266.39 feet; thence, North 00°01'26" East, 166.23 feet; thence, South 83°24'00" East, 508.26 feet to the point of beginning. And lying in the NE 1/4 of the NE 1/4 of

1 Section 12 Township 15 South, Range 1 East, St. Clair County, Alabama.

2 Section 2. In accordance with Section 11-42-6(b) of
3 the Code of Alabama 1975, a map showing what territory is
4 proposed to be annexed to the City of Springville is on file
5 in the office of the Judge of Probate in St. Clair County,
6 Alabama, and the map is open to the inspection of the public.

7 Section 3. This act shall become effective on the
8 first day of the third month following its passage and
9 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
