2 ENROLLED, An Act,

3 Relating to Cullman County; to provide for the
4 appointment of the county superintendent of education; and to
5 repeal Sections 3 and 6 of Acts 1955, No. 18, 1955 First
6 Special Session (Acts 1955, p. 45), now appearing as Sections
7 45-22-100.02 and 45-22-100.05, Code of Alabama 1975; Acts
8 1955, No. 13, 1955 Regular Session (Acts 1955, p. 224); Acts
9 1969, No. 309, 1969 Regular Session (Acts 1969, p. 644); and
10 Acts 1973, No. 529, 1973 Regular Session (Acts 1973, p. 529),
11 relating to the election of the Cullman County Superintendent
12 of Education.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

14 Section 1. (a) Beginning at the time of expiration
15 of the current term of office of the Cullman County
16 Superintendent of Education, and thereafter, the Cullman
17 County Superintendent of Education shall be appointed by the
18 Cullman County Board of Education in accordance with Chapter
19 9, Title 16, Code of Alabama 1975. The appointed
20 superintendent shall take office on the date prescribed by
21 general law, and shall serve for a term of two years to four
22 years from the first day of July next succeeding his or her
23 appointment. Any vacancy in the office of county
24 superintendent of education in the time interim between the
25 vacation of the office due to expiration of the term of the

1 prior county superintendent of education or due to other
2 causes and the assuming of office by the first county
3 superintendent of education appointed pursuant to this act
4 shall be filled for the duration of the unexpired term by the
5 county board of education in the manner prescribed by general
6 law. The appointment shall terminate on the date the first
7 county superintendent of education appointed pursuant to this
8 act assumes office. The compensation of the interim appointee
9 shall be set by the county board of education and the interim
10 appointee shall serve at the pleasure of the county board of
11 education.

12 (b) The Cullman County Superintendent of Education
13 shall possess all the qualifications prescribed for county
14 superintendents of education by the general laws of the state,
15 shall possess all the powers granted by the general laws of
16 the state, and shall perform and discharge all the duties of
17 county superintendents of education prescribed by the general
18 laws of the state.

19 (c) The Cullman County Superintendent of Education
20 shall receive compensation in an amount as set by the Cullman
21 County Board of Education.

22 Section 2. All laws or parts of laws which conflict
23 with this act are repealed. Specifically, Sections 3 and 6 of
24 Acts 1955, No. 18, 1955 First Special Session (Acts 1955, p.
25 45), now appearing as Sections 45-22-100.02 and 45-22-100.05,

2 (Acts 1955, p. 224); Acts 1969, No. 309, 1969 Regular Session
3 (Acts 1969, p. 644); and Acts 1973, No. 529, 1973 Regular
4 Session (Acts 1973, p. 529), relating to the election of the
5 Cullman County Superintendent of Education are repealed.

6 Section 3. This act shall become effective
7 immediately following its passage and approval by the
8 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
