10 TO BE ENTITLED  
11 AN ACT

13 Relating to Cullman County; to provide for the  
14 appointment of the county superintendent of education; and to  
15 repeal Sections 3 and 6 of Acts 1955, No. 18, 1955 First  
16 Special Session (Acts 1955, p. 45), now appearing as Sections  
17 45-22-100.02 and 45-22-100.05, Code of Alabama 1975; Acts  
18 1955, No. 13, 1955 Regular Session (Acts 1955, p. 224); Acts  
19 1969, No. 309, 1969 Regular Session (Acts 1969, p. 644); and  
20 Acts 1973, No. 529, 1973 Regular Session (Acts 1973, p. 529),  
21 relating to the election of the Cullman County Superintendent  
22 of Education.

23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

24 Section 1. (a) Beginning at the time of expiration  
25 of the current term of office of the Cullman County  
26 Superintendent of Education, and thereafter, the Cullman  
27 County Superintendent of Education shall be appointed by the

1 Cullman County Board of Education in accordance with Chapter  
2 9, Title 16, Code of Alabama 1975. The appointed  
3 superintendent shall take office on the date prescribed by  
4 general law, and shall serve for a term of two years to four  
5 years from the first day of July next succeeding his or her  
6 appointment. Any vacancy in the office of county  
7 superintendent of education in the time interim between the  
8 vacation of the office due to expiration of the term of the  
9 prior county superintendent of education or due to other  
10 causes and the assuming of office by the first county  
11 superintendent of education appointed pursuant to this act  
12 shall be filled for the duration of the unexpired term by the  
13 county board of education in the manner prescribed by general  
14 law. The appointment shall terminate on the date the first  
15 county superintendent of education appointed pursuant to this  
16 act assumes office. The compensation of the interim appointee  
17 shall be set by the county board of education and the interim  
18 appointee shall serve at the pleasure of the county board of  
19 education.

20 (b) The Cullman County Superintendent of Education  
21 shall possess all the qualifications prescribed for county  
22 superintendents of education by the general laws of the state,  
23 shall possess all the powers granted by the general laws of  
24 the state, and shall perform and discharge all the duties of  
25 county superintendents of education prescribed by the general  
26 laws of the state.

1                   (c) The Cullman County Superintendent of Education  
2 shall receive compensation in an amount as set by the Cullman  
3 County Board of Education.

4                   Section 2. All laws or parts of laws which conflict  
5 with this act are repealed. Specifically, Sections 3 and 6 of  
6 Acts 1955, No. 18, 1955 First Special Session (Acts 1955, p.  
7 45), now appearing as Sections 45-22-100.02 and 45-22-100.05,  
8 Code of Alabama 1975; Acts 1955, No. 13, 1955 Regular Session  
9 (Acts 1955, p. 224); Acts 1969, No. 309, 1969 Regular Session  
10 (Acts 1969, p. 644); and Acts 1973, No. 529, 1973 Regular  
11 Session (Acts 1973, p. 529), relating to the election of the  
12 Cullman County Superintendent of Education are repealed.

13                   Section 3. This act shall become effective  
14 immediately following its passage and approval by the  
15 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
