11 Ashland, Alabama, on April 23, 2013, with deep sadness; his
12 immeasurable and precious life of 61 years is celebrated and
13 commended with great thanksgiving; and

14 WHEREAS, the passing of Mr. Wheelles leaves a void in
15 the lives of his loving family, many friends, and the entire
16 community, where he was highly regarded; and

17 WHEREAS, a native and lifelong resident of Clay
18 County, Mr. Wheelles graduated from Clay County High School in
19 1969 and was employed with the Ashland Housing Authority, the
20 Alabama National Guard 127th Medical Group, and as an agent
21 with Liberty National Insurance; an icon first responder in
22 Ashland and Clay County, he served the Clay County Rescue
23 Squad for many years and as Chief of the Ashland Fire
24 Department for 20 years; notably, he was instrumental in the
25 launch of Clay County's E911 Agency; and

26 WHEREAS, an avid Clay County High School football
27 fan, Mr. Wheelles served as the school's public address

1 announcer for 20 years; he enjoyed portraying a number of
2 roles in the local community theatre; and

3 WHEREAS, a humorous man, Mr. Wheelles was known for
4 his jokes, pranks, and enthusiastic storytelling; a devoted
5 husband, father, and grandfather, he deeply cared for others
6 and was a member of First Baptist Church in Ashland and Jimmy
7 Allen's Sunday School Class; and

8 WHEREAS, survivors include his beloved wife, Betty
9 Kay Wheelles; two daughters, Lori McCain (Tommy) and Michelle
10 Thompson; one son, Brandon Pollard (Autumn); four sisters,
11 Nadine Kennedy, Ida Randall, Mamie Kennedy, and Glenda Amason;
12 two brothers, W.C. Wheelles and John Wheelles; and five
13 grandchildren, Kaley McCain, Caden McCain, Ivy McCain, Masen
14 Marshall, and Carter Thompson; and

15 WHEREAS, Mr. Wheelles was a valued member of the
16 community; although his presence is greatly missed, his memory
17 is cherished in the hearts and minds of those who were
18 fortunate enough to know him; now therefore,
