12 "Curt" Williams, Sr., on February 19, 2013, with deep sadness;
13 we commend and celebrate his invaluable life with

16 the late Jimmie Lee Williams, Sr., and Mary Nell Williams in
17 Eufaula, Alabama, and Clark Tyrone (Bernice) Wilson of Newark,
18 New Jersey; he accepted Christ and joined First Baptist Church
19 in Eufaula, Alabama, under the leadership of Dr. Ken Bush; he
20 was a faithful member of the First Baptist Church Breakfast
21 Team located in the Eufaula Historical District; he graduated
22 from TV McCoo High School in 1968 and from Columbus Vocational
23 Community College and Sparks Technical College with a degree
24 in Radio and TV Repair; and

25 WHEREAS, Mr. Williams learned to cut hair at an
26 early age and began working with his grandfather, "Putt", in

1 his barber shop; in 1966, Williams Barber Shop was established
2 along with Williams Radio and TV Repair; he served his country
3 in the United States Navy, where he was the ship barber;
4 actively involved, he was a board member of the Eufaula Lions
5 Club, Main Street Eufaula, Historical Preservation Commission,
6 and the Eufaula Heritage Association; he was an individual for
7 the people and touched the lives of many; and

9 (Johnny Ray) Lewis; three sons, Curtis (Musheera) Williams,
10 Dangelo Williams, and Fernando Williams; two step-sons, Angel

12 Jahlyn, De'Jiah, and Jave' Williams, and Trinity Helen Ocasio;
13 the mother of his children, Diane Williams McClendon; his

16 Knight, Beverly (Hampton) Underwood, Octavia Thomas, Ludie
