10 WHEREAS, official dedication ceremonies for the
11 National Veterans Shrine under construction at the American
12 Village in Montevallo, Alabama, will be held on November 10,
13 2013; and

14 WHEREAS, the National Veterans Shrine at the
15 American Village will honor the patriotic service and
16 sacrifice of veterans who have served in the United States
17 Armed Forces and active military service members by their
18 inclusion in the Veterans Register of Honor; and

19 WHEREAS, the National Veterans Shrine is patterned
20 after Carpenters' Hall in Philadelphia, the meeting place of
21 the First Continental Congress and will present the
22 photographs, biographical sketches, and personal stories of
23 our United States veterans and active military service
24 members, and will serve to educate and inspire generations to
25 come of the vital lessons of liberty and those who have
26 defended it; and

1 WHEREAS, the Honorable George W. Bush, former United
2 States President and former Commander-in-Chief, is being
3 invited by the American Village Citizenship Trust to make an
4 address at the official dedicatory ceremonies; now therefore,

5 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF
6 THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, That we do hereby join the
7 American Village Citizenship Trust in extending the invitation
8 for the Honorable George W. Bush, 43rd President of the United
9 States, to speak at the official dedication of the National
10 Veterans Shrine on Sunday, November 10, 2013.

11 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That a copy of this
12 resolution be prepared for transmittal by the American Village
13 Citizenship Trust to former President and Mrs. George W. Bush
14 as a sincere expression of our hope that they will accept this
15 invitation and as a signal of the hospitality and best wishes
