11 Relating to motor vehicles; to provide for the
12 issuance of a distinctive motorcycle license plate for breast
13 cancer research under certain conditions; to provide for an
14 additional annual fee; to provide for the distribution of the
15 net proceeds; and to provide for the design.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

17 Section 1. (a) Notwithstanding the provisions of
18 Section 32-6-64, Code of Alabama 1975, upon application to the
19 judge of probate, license commissioner, or other issuing
20 official, compliance with motor vehicle registration and
21 licensing laws, payment of regular fees required by law for
22 motorcycle license tags or plates, and payment of an annual
23 additional fee of fifty dollars (\$50), owners of motorcycles
24 who are residents of Alabama shall be issued distinctive
25 "Breast Cancer Research" motorcycle license tags or plates.
26 The motorcycle tags or plates shall be numbered or
27 personalized. These tags or plates shall be valid for five

1 years and may then be replaced with either conventional,
2 personalized, or new "Breast Cancer Research" motorcycle tags
3 or plates. Notwithstanding the provisions of this section, the
4 motorcycle tags or plates shall only be printed and issued as
5 long as the Breast Cancer Research Foundation of Alabama
6 qualifies for a distinctive license plate category pursuant to
7 Section 32-6-64, Code of Alabama 1975, for passenger cars,
8 pickup trucks, and self-propelled campers or house cars.

9 (b) Payment of required license fees and taxes for
10 the years during which a new tag or plate is not issued shall
11 be evidenced as provided in Section 32-6-63, Code of Alabama
12 1975.

13 (c) The Breast Cancer Research Foundation of Alabama
14 shall be responsible for the design of the distinctive
15 motorcycle license plate subject to approval by the
16 Commissioner of Revenue and compliance with all laws and
17 regulations.

18 (d) The annual additional fee for the motorcycle
19 plates shall be distributed in accordance with the provisions
20 of Section 32-6-68, Code of Alabama 1975. The Breast Cancer
21 Research Foundation of Alabama portion of the fee shall be
22 used to provide funding for breast cancer research in the
23 State of Alabama.

24 (e) The Department of Revenue may promulgate rules
25 to implement this section.

26 Section 2. This act shall become effective on
27 January 1, 2014.
