27	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. (a) Notwithstanding the provisions of Section 32-6-64, Code of Alabama 1975, upon application to the judge of probate or license commissioner, compliance with motor vehicle registration and licensing laws, payment of regular fees required by law for license plates for private passenger or pleasure motorcycles, and payment of an additional annual fee of fifty dollars (\$50), owners of motorcycles who are residents of Alabama shall be issued distinctive "Breast Cancer Research" license plates.

- (b) These plates shall be valid for five years, and may then be replaced with either conventional, personalized, or new "Breast Cancer Research" plates.
- (c) Payment of required license fees and taxes for the years during which a new plate is not issued shall be evidenced as provided in Section 32-6-63, Code of Alabama 1975.
- (d) The Breast Cancer Research Foundation of Alabama shall design, or have designed, the plate, which design shall be approved by the Commissioner of Revenue. Section 32-6-54, Code of Alabama 1975, shall not apply to the plates designed pursuant to this section.
- (e) The plates shall be issued, printed, and processed like other distinctive and personalized plates provided for in Chapter 6 of Title 32.
- (f) The annual additional fee for the motorcycle plates shall be distributed in accordance with Section 32-6-68 of the Code of Alabama 1975. The Breast Cancer Research

- Foundation of Alabama portion of the fee shall be used to 1 2 provide funding for breast cancer research in the State of Alabama. 3 (g) The Department of Revenue may promulgate rules to implement this act. 5 Section 2. All laws or parts of laws which conflict 6 7 with this act are repealed. Section 3. The provisions of this act are severable. 8 If any part of this act is declared invalid or 9 10 unconstitutional, that declaration shall not affect the part
- Section 4. This act shall become effective on

 January 1, 2013, following its passage and approval by the

 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
