Buskey who originally 17 sponsored the fee. 18 19 A BILL 20 TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT 21 22 To amend Section 32-6-68 of the Code of Alabama 23 24 1975, providing for an additional fee for the issuance of distinctive license plates, to further provide for the 25 distribution of the fee to the Department of Senior Services 26 for meals for seniors. 27

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA: 1 Section 1. Section 32-6-68 of the Code of Alabama 2 1975, is amended to read as follows: 3 "§32-6-68. 4 "(a) Effective January 1, 1997, each new distinctive 5 license plate issued shall require, in addition to the 6 7 standard registration fee, an additional annual fee of fifty dollars (\$50). 8 "(b) The additional license plate fee as provided 9 10 for in subsection (a) shall be distributed in the following 11 manner: 12 "(1) Two and one-half percent commission, provided by Section 40-12-269(a)(1). 13 "(2) Manufacturing costs of one dollar and fifty 14 cents (\$1.50) to the Department of Corrections. 15 "(3) Administrative costs of one dollar (\$1) to the 16 17 Department of Revenue. "(4) State shares A state share of five dollars (\$5) 18 shall be transmitted to the state Comptroller for deposit into 19 20 the Penny Trust Fund as established by Amendment 512 of the 21 Constitution of Alabama of 1901 in an account maintained by 22 the Department of Senior Services to be used by the department 23 to provide meals to senior citizens under a program to be 24 known as the "John L. Buskey Senior Meals Program." Funds 25 deposited in the account are continuously appropriated to the 26 department for the purpose of this subdivision.

1 "(5) The remainder of the additional fee shall be 2 distributed to the sponsoring organization or as otherwise 3 provided under the terms of the application approved by the 4 legislative oversight committee.

5 "(c) The distribution of fees for tags which were 6 authorized by legislative act before January 1, 1998, shall 7 continue in effect, any other provision of law to the contrary 8 notwithstanding."

9 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the 10 first day of the third month following its passage and 11 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
