9 A BILL  
10 TO BE ENTITLED  
11 AN ACT  
12

13 To alter, rearrange, and extend the boundary lines  
14 and corporate limits of the City of Foley in Baldwin County.  
15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

16 Section 1. The boundary lines and corporate limits  
17 of the City of Foley in Baldwin County are altered,  
18 rearranged, and extended to include within the corporate  
19 limits of the city, in addition to the lands now included, all  
20 of the following territory:

21 Tract 1

22 The Northeast Quarter of Section 22, Township 7  
23 South, Range 4 East, Baldwin County, Alabama, consisting of  
24 approximately 159.5 acres and including any existing  
25 rights-of-way.

26 Tract 2

1           The North Half of the Southeast Quarter of Section  
2           22, Township 7 South, Range 4 East, Baldwin County, Alabama,  
3           consisting of approximately 80 acres and including any  
4           existing rights-of-way.

5           Tract 3

6           Commence at the Southeast corner of Section 9,  
7           Township 7 South, Range 4 East, Baldwin County, Alabama, which  
8           is also the Point of Beginning; thence run North approximately  
9           2,550 feet to a point on the Eastern boundary of said Section  
10          9; thence run South 88° 50' 38" West approximately 2,655 feet  
11          to a point on the Eastern boundary of the West Half of said  
12          Section 9; thence run South approximately 2,500 feet to a  
13          point which is the Southeast corner of the West Half of said  
14          Section 9; thence run East approximately 2,654 feet to the  
15          Point of Beginning, said tract of land containing  
16          approximately 154 acres and including all existing  
17          rights-of-way.

18          Section 2. In accordance with Section 11-42-6(b) of  
19          the Code of Alabama 1975, a map showing what territory is  
20          proposed to be annexed to the City of Foley is on file in the  
21          office of the Judge of Probate in Baldwin County, Alabama, and  
22          the map is open to the inspection of the public.

23          Section 3. This act shall become effective on the  
24          first day of the third month following its passage and  
25          approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
