8	ENCOURAGING GOVERNOR BENTLEY TO END THE FREEZE ON
9	STATE EMPLOYEE MERIT RAISES.

11	WHEREAS, state employee merit raises have been
12	frozen since December 15, 2008; and
13	WHEREAS, since 2008, the amount state employees
14	contribute toward their retirement has increased by 50
15	percent; and
16	WHEREAS, since 2008, the cost of state employee
17	health insurance has increased by no less than one hundred
18	eighty dollars (\$180) a year; and
19	WHEREAS, since 2008, the Consumer Price Index rate
20	of inflation has increased by nine percent; and
21	WHEREAS, the Social Security payroll tax holiday
22	ended January 1, 2013, causing employees to lose an additional
23	two percent of their pay; and
24	WHEREAS, merit raises are earned by state employees
25	based on annual performance appraisals as promised by the
26	State of Alabama pursuant to the state's approved pay plan and
27	have been frozen since December 15, 2008; and

WHEREAS, state employees eligible for merit raises 1 2 since the freeze began in 2008 have permanently lost up to 20 percent in earned merit pay increases; and 3 WHEREAS, employees have lost 13 1/2 percent in pay or purchasing power since October 1, 2008; and 5 WHEREAS, the worst situated employees have suffered 6 7 more than 33 percent in lost earned merit raises, pay, and purchasing power since 2008; and 8 WHEREAS, the freeze on merit raises and loss of pay 9 10 and purchasing power has severely damaged the morale of the 11 state workforce; now therefore, 12 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH 13 HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That by copy of this resolution 14 provided to the Governor, we hereby encourage Governor Bentley to take all steps necessary to immediately end the freeze on 15 state employee merit raises. 16
