2 Any law enforcement officer or constable may issue a citation alleging a violation of the ordinance. The ordinance may 3 4 provide that the person charged with a violation may pay a civil fine or request, within 30 days of receipt of the 5 6 citation, a due process hearing before the county commission 7 or its hearing officer on the validity of the citation. An order of the county commission finding a violation and an 8 assessment of a civil fine shall be final within 30 days 9 10 thereof unless appealed to the Circuit Court in Randolph County based on the administrative record of the hearing. Any 11 12 fine due and owing shall be considered a debt owed to the 13 Randolph County Commission and shall be enforceable by civil 14 action in the same manner as any other debt. The person owing the fine shall be liable for all costs, including court costs 15 and attorney fees, and all other expenses of litigation if 16 17 action is taken to collect the fine owed.
