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8 SYNOPSIS: This bill would require the State Department
9 of Finance to develop and maintain an automated
10 inventory of all facilities and lands owned,
11 leased, rented, or otherwise occupied or maintained
12 by any agency of the state or by the judicial
13 branch.

19 Relating to the State Department of Finance; to
20 require the department to develop and maintain an automated
21 inventory of all facilities and lands owned, leased, rented,
22 or otherwise occupied or maintained by any agency of the state
23 or by the judicial branch; to provide for certain exceptions;
24 and to provide for updates.

25 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

26 Section 1. (a) (1) The State Department of Finance
27 shall develop and maintain an automated inventory of all

1 facilities and lands owned, leased, rented, or otherwise
2 occupied or maintained by any agency of the state or by the
3 judicial branch. The facilities inventory shall include the
4 location, occupying agency, and ownership.

5 (2) For the purposes of this section, the term
6 facility means buildings, structures, and building systems,
7 and does not include facilities of the State Department of
8 Transportation.

9 (3) The State Department of Transportation shall
10 develop and maintain an inventory of their own facilities,
11 which inventories should be available to the public online.

12 (4) The Alabama Commission on Higher Education and
13 the State Department of Postsecondary Education, respectively,
14 shall develop and maintain a facilities inventory, in the
15 manner prescribed by the State Department of Finance, of all
16 state university and community college facilities and shall
17 make the data available in a format acceptable to the State
18 Department of Finance.

19 (5) The lands inventory shall include the location
20 and ownership.

21 (6) The State Department of Finance shall utilize
22 any available information from existing inventories of
23 facilities and lands to develop and maintain the inventory as
24 required by this section, including any information about
25 state lands managed by the State Lands Division of the
26 Department of Conservation and Natural Resources.

1 (b) The State Department of Finance shall update the
2 automated inventory, and cause to be updated the other
3 inventories required by subsection (a), at least one time
4 every 3 years. Notwithstanding the foregoing, the inventories
5 shall be updated to reflect acquisitions of new facilities and
6 lands and significant changes in existing facilities and lands
7 as they occur. The State Department of Finance shall provide
8 each agency and the judicial branch with the most recent
9 inventory applicable to that agency or branch. Each agency and
10 branch, in the manner prescribed by the State Department of
11 Finance, shall report significant changes in the inventory as
12 they occur.

13 (c) The automated inventory required by this section
14 shall be maintained on the website of the State Department of
15 Finance for access by the public.

16 Section 2. This act shall become effective January
17 1, 2014, following its passage and approval by the Governor,
18 or its otherwise becoming law.
