14	Section 1. Section 32-6-1.2, Code of Alabama 1975,
15	is amended to read as follows:

17	"(a) The driver's license of a resident of this
18	state who is an honorably discharged veteran as evidenced by
19	the veteran's DD Form 214, or if the veteran does not have a
20	DD Form 214, as evidenced by the veteran's Record and Report
21	of Separation Honorable Discharge Record, upon request of the
22	eligible veteran, shall have the word veteran displayed on the
23	license.
24	"(b) The Department of Public Safety may not impose
25	any charge in addition to the driver's license fee for the
26	issuance or renewal of a veteran's driver's license."

1	Section 2. (a) The nondriver identification card of
2	a resident of this state who is an honorably discharged
3	veteran as evidenced by the veteran's DD Form 214, or if the
4	veteran does not have a DD Form 214, as evidenced by the
5	veteran's Record and Report of Separation Honorable Discharge
6	Record, upon request of the eligible veteran, shall have the
7	word veteran displayed on the nondriver identification card.
8	(b) The Department of Public Safety may not impose
9	any charge in addition to the nondriver identification card
10	fee for the issuance or renewal of a veteran's nondriver
11	identification card.
12	Section 3. This act shall become effective on the
13	first day of the third month following its passage and
14	approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
