ENROLLED, An Act,

To alter, rearrange, and extend the boundary lines and corporate limits of the City of Summerdale in Baldwin County.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. The boundary lines and corporate limits of the City of Summerdale in Baldwin County are altered, rearranged, and extended to include within the corporate limits of the city, in addition to the lands now included, all of the following territory:

Commencing at the Southeast corner of the Northwest Quarter of Section 12, Township 7 South, Range 3 East, Baldwin County, Alabama; thence run West for a distance of 30 feet, more or less, to the West right-of-way line of George Younce Road and the Point of Beginning; thence continue running West for a distance of 390 feet to a point; thence continue running West for a distance of 390 feet to a point; thence run North for a distance of 210 feet to a point; thence run East for a distance of 390 feet to a point on the West right-of-way line of George Younce Road; thence run South along said right-of-way line for a distance of 210 feet to the Point of Beginning.

Section 2. In accordance with Section 11-42-6 of the Code of Alabama 1975, a map showing what territory is proposed

1 to be annexed to the City of Summerdale is on file and open to  
2 public inspection in the office of the Judge of Probate in  
3 Baldwin County, Alabama.

4 Section 3. This act shall become effective on the  
5 first day of the third month following its passage and  
6 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
