- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
- 4 Section 1. (a) The Legislature hereby finds,
- 5 determines, and declares the following:
- 6 (1) Significant inequitable disparities exist in the
- 7 limits and boundaries of the territorial waters and submerged
- 8 lands among the Gulf Coast States of Texas, Florida,
- 9 Louisiana, Mississippi, and Alabama.
- 10 (2) These inequities have resulted in economic and
- 11 recreational losses to the State of Alabama, its political
- 12 subdivisions, and its citizens.
- 13 (3) It is the policy and purpose of the State of
- 14 Alabama by this act to place itself on an equal footing with
