10 TO BE ENTITLED
11 AN ACT
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13 Relating to Morgan County; to provide for the
14 allocation and expenditure of money received from the
15 Tennessee Valley Authority and distributed to Morgan County
16 pursuant to Act 2010-135, 2010 Regular Session (Acts 2010, p.
17 190), for certain fiscal years; and to repeal Act 2013-328 of
18 the 2013 Regular Session.

19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

20 Section 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of
21 law, after the allocation of the proceeds pursuant to Act
22 2013-199 of the 2013 Regular Session, any remaining proceeds
23 allocated to Morgan County pursuant to Act 2010-135, 2010
24 Regular Session (Acts 2010, p. 190), from the in-lieu-of-taxes
25 payments made by the Tennessee Valley Authority shall be
26 distributed as follows:

1 (1) For the fiscal years 2014, 2015, and 2016 only,
2 one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) each year shall be
3 distributed to the United Way of Morgan County for the sole
4 purpose of funding the Starting Strong Pre-K Initiative for a
5 countywide pre-K program.

6 (2) For the fiscal years 2014, 2015, 2016, 2017, and
7 2018, the remaining proceeds shall be distributed as follows:

8 a. Ninety-three thousand five hundred dollars
9 (\$93,500) each year to the City of Hartselle for lighting at
10 the municipal soccer fields in the City of Hartselle.

11 b. One hundred fifty-six thousand seven hundred
12 fifty dollars (\$156,750) each year to the City of Decatur for
13 capital improvements to Jack Allen Park.

14 c. Twenty-two thousand eight hundred dollars
15 (\$22,800) each year to the Town of Priceville for the funding
16 of Veteran's Park.

17 d. Three thousand nine hundred ninety dollars
18 (\$3,990) each year to the Town of Eva for improvements to Eva
19 Park.

20 e. Nine thousand five hundred dollars (\$9,500) each
21 year to the Town of Falkville for improvements to McCaig Park.

22 f. Five thousand seven hundred dollars (\$5,700) each
23 year to the Town of Somerville for improvements to the Old
24 Somerville Courthouse.

25 g. Fifteen thousand six hundred seventy-five dollars
26 (\$15,675) each year to the Town of Trinity for improvements to
27 Trinity Municipal Park.

1 h. Sixty-two thousand eight hundred eighty-five
2 dollars (\$62,885) each year to the Morgan County Commission
3 for capital improvements in the four primary county
4 recreational parks, to be administered and disbursed by the
5 county commission after consultation with the county
6 legislative delegation.

7 i. In the event that there are not sufficient funds
8 to make the full amount of distributions in paragraphs a. to
9 h., those distribution amounts shall be distributed
10 proportionately.

11 (3) Upon payment of the above distributions, any
12 remainder shall be distributed each year to the Morgan County
13 legislative delegation office.

14 Section 2. Act 2013-328 of the 2013 Regular Session
15 is repealed.

16 Section 3. This act shall become effective on the
17 first day of the third month following its passage and
18 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
