8 SYNOPSIS: Act 2013-443 of the 2013 Regular Session of
9 the Legislature exempted certain medical equipment
10 and supplies sold pursuant to a valid prescription
11 and billed to a third party payer from state,
12 county and municipal sales and use taxes. The
13 provisions of the bill will become effective
14 October 1, 2014.

15 This bill would change the effective date of
16 Act 2013-443 to August 1, 2014.

25 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

26 Section 1. Notwithstanding any provision of law to
27 the contrary, the effective date of Act 2013-443 of the 2013

1 Regular Session of the Legislature, now appearing as Section
2 40-9-39.1, Code of Alabama 1975, shall become effective August
3 1, 2014.

4 Section 2. This act shall become effective
5 immediately upon its passage and approval by the Governor, or
6 its otherwise becoming law.
