10 TO BE ENTITLED
11 AN ACT
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13 Relating to Bibb County; to amend Act 2013-407, 2013
14 Regular Session, now appearing as Section 45-4-235, Code of
15 Alabama 1975, to provide further for the operation of the jail
16 store; to authorize the county commission at the request of
17 the sheriff to contract with a provider to supply and operate
18 the jail store; and to remove a provision that the funds
19 generated be earmarked to fund certain salary increases.

20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

21 Section 1. Act 2013-407 of the 2013 Regular Session,
22 now appearing as Section 45-4-235, Code of Alabama 1975, is
23 amended to read as follows:

24 "§45-4-235.

25 "(a) The Sheriff of Bibb County or the authorized
26 agents of the sheriff may operate a jail store for prisoners
27 within the confines of the county jail. The jail store shall

1 be operated to serve the needs of the jail population. The
2 county commission, at the request of the sheriff, may contract
3 with a provider to supply and operate the jail store.

4 "(b) All proceeds collected under this section shall
5 be deposited in the county general fund. ~~All jail store~~
6 ~~transactions shall be accounted for in the fund. When~~
7 ~~presented with a request from the sheriff, the county~~
8 ~~commission shall provide the sheriff with the total amount~~
9 ~~generated from the jail store.~~

10 "~~(c) All revenue generated by the jail store shall~~
11 ~~be deposited into the county general fund earmarked solely to~~
12 ~~fund an increase in salaries of the employees in the sheriff's~~
13 ~~department.~~

14 "~~(d) (c)~~ The sheriff shall keep an account of all
15 jail store sales. The jail store account shall be audited at
16 the same time other accounts of the sheriff are audited. The
17 Department of Examiners of Public Accounts shall submit a copy
18 of the audit to the sheriff and county commission within 30
19 days of its completion."

20 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the
21 first day of the third month following its passage and
22 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
