13 Relating to Lowndes County; to provide for an
14 increase in the salary of an incumbent judge of probate
15 commencing upon the seventeenth year in office.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

17 Section 1. If the incumbent Judge of Probate of
18 Lowndes County on the effective date of this act is in office
19 for 16 years, commencing upon the seventeenth year of office,
20 the annual compensation paid to the Judge of Probate of
21 Lowndes County shall be equal to 90 percent of the annual
22 salary paid by the state to the state district court judge in
23 Lowndes County. The salary shall be paid in lieu of all other
24 fees and allowances heretofore provided by law, and shall be
25 paid in equal installments, as are other county employees.

1 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the
2 first day of the third month following its passage and
3 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
