ENROLLED, House Joint Resolution,
DESIGNATING THE JOSH NEWMAN HIGHWAY.

WHEREAS, with highest tribute and deepest appreciation, the service of the late police officer Josh Newman of Chilton County is herein recognized and honored; and

WHEREAS, Officer Newman was dedicated to serving and protecting the City of Jemison, Alabama, and lost his life in the line of duty on March 5, 2011, at only 30 years of age; and

WHEREAS, Officer Newman was a resident of Clanton, Alabama; he served in the United States Air Force for six years prior to becoming a police officer for the City of Jemison; he began serving the City of Jemison as a Reserve Officer in 2008 and completed the Police Academy in April 2010; and

WHEREAS, serving with distinction and honor, Josh Newman dedicated his life to public service and it is appropriate to name a highway in Chilton County to memorialize his legacy; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That in memory of police officer Josh Newman, we hereby designate the portion of United States

1 Highway 31 from mile marker 227 to mile marker 233 as the
2 "Josh Newman Highway."

3 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the appropriate public
4 authorities are respectfully requested to install and maintain
5 signs and markers designating the described route as The Josh
6 Newman Highway.

7 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That a copy of this
8 resolution be presented to the family of Police Officer Josh
9 Newman, so that they may know of the esteem in which we hold
10 their fallen family member and the service he made to his
11 country, his state, and Chilton County.
