ENROLLED, House Joint Resolution,
COMMENDING BRANDON WOMACK OF SCOTTSBORO ON WINNING
HIS SIXTH STATE WRESTLING CHAMPIONSHIP.

WHEREAS, it is with highest commendation that
Brandon Womack of Scottsboro is recognized on winning his
sixth State Championship at the 2014 AHSAA Wrestling
Championships in Huntsville, Alabama; and

WHEREAS, Brandon Womack is the most celebrated
wrestler in the history of the sport in Alabama; he has a
career total of 422 wins and only eight losses, and he owns
State and National Records for both Career Wins and Career
Wins via pin (327); and

WHEREAS, Brandon Womack has won 37 Career Tournament
Championships and holds the distinction of being a five-time
winner of the Class 5A Most Outstanding Wrestler Award; and

WHEREAS, Brandon Womack won his first State Title,
the 5A 103-Pound Weight Class, as a seventh-grader, repeated
the victory the following year, then won the 112-Pound Weight
Class as a freshman and the 126-Pound Weight Class as a
sophomore; his junior and senior year State Championships both
came in the 160-Pound Weight Class; and

1 WHEREAS, Brandon Womack finished his final season at
2 Scottsboro High School with a 77-0 record, the most wins ever
3 by an Alabama wrestler during a perfect season; and

4 WHEREAS, Brandon Womack's is one of only two
5 wrestlers in the State of Alabama to win six State
6 Championships; and

7 WHEREAS, the athletic accomplishments of Brandon
8 Womack are the source of justifiable pride to his family, his
9 school, and the entire community, and he is truly deserving of
10 special recognition for his diligent commitment to the pursuit
11 of excellence; now there,

12 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH
13 HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That Brandon Womack of Scottsboro
14 is hereby most highly honored and commended, and this
15 resolution is offered with heartiest congratulations on
16 winning his Sixth State Wrestling Championship, along with
17 best wishes for continuing success in future endeavors.
